BUILDING STRONG LOCAL UNIONS

It is important that CUPE members in Alberta continue to work with their Local Unions to strive for the best! The best means engaging the membership and creating solidarity within your local, but also within the larger Labour movement and the community. This course will cover, issues, problem and solutions that are relevant to your local. You will learn strategies for making your local more inclusive and welcoming and you will work on an action plan that will strengthen your local.

COMBATING WORKPLACE BULLYING

Bullying has become an issue in many workplaces in Alberta. This course is designed to teach you what bullying is, how it hurts everyone, how to change from bystander to someone who will take action when we see bullying happening in our workplaces. Knowledge is the key to knowing that the Union can make a difference.

- How not to be a bystander
- How the union can make a difference
